

History

Casa da Criança e do Jovem Amparense is a non-profit civil institution whose mission is supporting young people to have access to better psychopedagogical, professional and citizenship training for the future.

Casa da Criança was created in The achievement has already in Santo Antonio 1987 Amparo, Minas Gerais, Brazil, to serve the most needy children and youth. In the mid-1990s, the institution was closed for 10 years without fulfilling its mission. In 2015, motivated by the Painting Competition "O Mundo do Café", held in late 2014 by Fazenda da Lagoa/Neumann Group (NKG) in partnership with the Neumann Foundation, municipal schools and other local actors, a working group was formed to create and strengthen a platform to support the development of a better future for youth in communities.

With this mission, the new Casa Criança е do Jovem Amparense was reopened in October 2016. In the first year (until December 2017), Casa da Criança supported 300 young people and their families with the help of its partners (NKG, Neumann Foundation, SENAR MG, Rural Union of Santo Antônio do Amparo, City Hall, etc); it offered 16 training courses for professionalization and social activities; created and leveraged sport initiatives such as the Taekwondo Project, the Sports Project and Music Classes; and innovated the coffee sector by creating, in partnership SENAR MG, the first vocational course for the rural youth in Brazil, focused on training young people to work in coffee mechanization.

changed lives and transformed the future of many young people, preventing them from prostitution (young woman's report), and drug involvement due to a lack of future perspectives (reported by a young The project person). strengthened the generation of young champions and young athletes of the future, such as the Taekwondo project which today has 38 champions and runners-up from the state of Minas Gerais. 3 youngsters even entered in the National Brazilian Taekwondo Reserve Team for winning medals in the Brazilian Championship of Taekwondo in 2018.

All of these young people are cut off from the world of drugs and crime, and they can certainly be much better citizens compared to young people who do not get those opportunities. It is with the goal of increasing these young people's access to a better future that Casa da Criança is expanding its efforts to communicate these achievements and inviting other valuable partners to help us to increase the number of youth supported and facilitate inclusion of these young people in society.

Mechanization Course





- Mechanization Course was offered for the first time in 2017 in a partnership between SENAR MG, Fazenda da Lagoa - NKG, HRNS Brazil and Casa da Criança.
- It is a 3 months complete course that includes knowledge on steering and maintenance of tractors, different implements, spraying and harvesting machines.




